What is Dual Enrollment?

- ▶ Attending college while in high school. Earning high school and college credit for the same course.
 - Example: Taking English 1010 at Southern Crescent counts as both a high school English credit and an English credit in college.
- ▶ Dual enrollment classes last one semester and students earn **1 credit** per class. Students earn **.5 credits** per class each semester when taking classes at the high school. Dual enrollment is a faster way to complete more classes.
- ▶ Semester 1 begins in August and ends in December.
- ▶ Semester 2 begins in January and ends in May.
- ▶ **Dual enrollment classes do not count towards a student's HOPE scholarship hours but do count towards a student's HOPE GPA.**

What is the cost for Dual Enrollment?

- ▶ Tuition, books, and other mandatory fees are free.
- ▶ Students and parents are responsible for paying lab fees, supplies, tools, and other materials that are specific to a course.
- ▶ Students must take the Accuplacer, SAT, or ACT to dual enroll.
- ▶ The Accuplacer is free when administered at Ninth Grade Academy.
- ▶ There is a fee associated with taking the SAT and ACT that students or parents must pay.

Transportation

- ▶ Transportation is provided from Pike County to Griffin Regional College and Career Academy (GRCCA)
- ▶ Bus available to take students to Georgia Military College (GMC) on the way to GRCCA
- ▶ Transportation to Gordon College is determined on a yearly basis

Pike County Dual Enrollment Process for Students

1. Student and parent/ guardian must attend the Dual Enrollment Information Session at PCHS and sign off that they attended.
2. Take the Accuplacer, SAT, or ACT.
3. Apply to and be accepted to Southern Crescent, Gordon College, Georgia Military College, or GRCCA. Students must be accepted and provide acceptance to HS counselor by **MAY 1ST** in order to dual enroll during the upcoming school year.
4. After providing acceptance to their high school counselor, students must discuss course options with their high school counselor and complete the Pike County School System Dual Enrollment and Advisement Form.
5. Register for Dual Enrollment courses with college advisor.
6. Obtain a copy of college schedule and give to high school counselor.
7. Student must complete online application for dual enrollment through www.gafutures.org

Taking the Accuplacer

- ▶ Offered at NGA free of charge on Monday, October 15th and Monday, November 5th
- ▶ The test lasts a maximum of 3 hours, beginning around 8:30 am and ending by 11:30 am at the latest. Many students finish before then.
- ▶ Study resources are available in Ms. Stewart's office.
- ▶ Southern Crescent and Georgia Military College accept scores on the Accuplacer administered at NGA.
- ▶ Gordon College requires students to take the Accuplacer at Gordon and does not accept scores from Accuplacer tests administered outside of Gordon.
- ▶ The Accuplacer is generally considered to be easier than the SAT or ACT. This may factor into your decision of which test to take.
- ▶ The test is divided into Writing, Reading, and Math sections.
 - There are 20 Sentence Skills questions in the Writing Section
 - There are 20 Reading Comprehension questions
 - The Math section consists of 17 Arithmetic questions and 12 Algebra questions

Taking the PSAT

- ▶ The PSAT is a pre-test for the SAT. It is not the actual SAT.
- ▶ All 10th grade students are required to take the PSAT at the high school and it is free of charge.
- ▶ 9th grade students are also allowed to take the PSAT but it is not required.
- ▶ There is a \$16 fee for 9th grade students to take the PSAT. This fee can be paid by cash or check made out to PCHS and is due when students sign up.
- ▶ The deadline to sign up is Friday, September 28th. Students can sign up in Ms. Stewart's office.
- ▶ The PSAT will be administered at the high school on Wednesday, October 24th. The test will begin first thing in the morning, around 8 am, and will last until at least 12 pm.
- ▶ There will be a bus to take students from NGA to PCHS and back.
- ▶ There are study resources available in Ms. Stewart's office

Signing up for the SAT

- ▶ Create a user account at www.collegeboard.org
- ▶ Sign up for a specific testing date and location
- ▶ The cost is \$47.50 without the essay portion and \$64.50 with the essay portion
- ▶ Spalding High School in Griffin is a testing location that is nearby
- ▶ On the day of the test remember to have your scores sent to the college where you want to dual enroll.

- ▶ Register online at www.act.org
- ▶ The ACT costs \$50.50 without writing and \$67.00 with writing
- ▶ Select a test date and location when you register
- ▶ Griffin High School is a testing location that is nearby
- ▶ On the day of the test remember to have your scores sent to the college where you want to dual enroll.

Upon admission to the College, students desiring to enter an Allied Health program will be placed in either the Health Care Assistant (diploma) or the Health Care Management Degree (HC23) program while working on admission requirements for their chosen medical program. Acceptance into any Allied Health program is a competitive selection process.

Dual Allied Health or medical programs are not allowed. Health Care Assistant or Health Care Management students must complete their certificate before adding another major.

Students with Criminal Histories
